

Valid Voter Identification

One (1) of the following:

A currently valid:

- Utah driver license
- Utah identification card
- Utah concealed weapons permit
- United States passport
- Identification card issued by a branch, department or agency of the United States
- Tribal/Bureau of Indian Affairs identification card (whether or not the card includes your photograph)

Or two (2) of the following:

- A current utility bill dated within the last 90 days
- A bank or other financial account statement
- A certified birth certificate
- A valid Social Security Card
- A check issued by the state or federal government
- A paycheck from your employer
- A current valid Utah hunting or fishing license
- A current valid United States military identification card
- A certified naturalization documentation
- A current valid license issued by an authorized agency of the United States government.
 - A certified copy of court records showing the voter's adoption or name change.
 - Bureau of Indian Affairs card.
 - A tribal treaty card
 - A valid Medicaid card, Medicare card, or Electronic Benefits Transfer Card
 - A current valid ID card issued by a local government, employer, or college located within the state.
 - A current Utah vehicle registration
